

### **By-Law: Your Ideas**

This By-Law describes the process and procedures for Your Ideas at the GSA.

#### 1. Introduction

## 1.1. Interpretation

This By-Law shall be subject at all times to the provisions of the Articles and shall be read in conjunction therewith.

#### 1.2. Alterations of the By-Law

These By-Laws shall be amended from time to time by Association Council by a two-thirds majority.

# 2. Process and procedure:

- 2.1. Any member of the GSA can submit an idea to the Your Ideas platform at any time.
- 2.2. The Your Ideas submission must include the following:
  - 2.2.1. Name of Idea proposer
  - 2.2.2. University of York student number
  - 2.2.3. Email contact address
  - 2.2.4. Title of Idea
  - 2.2.5. Description of Idea
  - 2.2.6. Why you are proposing the idea
  - 2.2.7. What you want the GSA to do about it
- 2.3. The idea proposed must be based on the following criteria
  - 2.3.1. To make the University of York better for postgraduate students
  - 2.3.2. To make the York GSA better for postgraduate students
  - 2.3.3. To make York better for students

- 2.4. Once the idea has been submitted, the proposer will receive a confirmation email that the idea has been received by the York GSA team within 3-5 working days
- 2.5. The idea will then be considered and put into the following 4 categories:
  - 2.5.1. Gather support
  - 2.5.2. Taking action at the GSA
  - 2.5.3. Academic
  - 2.5.4. Policy
- 2.6. The proposer will then be contacted to discuss the next steps for their idea.
