## Vacation Dates

---

The University vacation starts on **Saturday 4 December 2021**. The new term begins on **Monday 10 January 2022**.

## Access to College Facilities and University Receptionists

---

College receptions will be open as normal until Thursday 23 December. Opening times will then be as follows:

## Security

---

Security staff will continue to patrol the campus 24 hours a day throughout the Vacation period and will provide a response service to queries and emergencies.

If you have an emergency situation and need to contact Security please use the phone (usually red) in your college foyer to contact Security. Alternatively, dial **3333** from any internal telephone, **01904 32 3333** from a mobile, or **0800 32 3333** to make a freephone call from a payphone or use the Safezone app. Your call will be answered by on duty Security Staff and your enquiry will be treated as an emergency.

If emergency services such as police, ambulance or fire brigade are required on campus, please dial **999**. Once you have contacted the emergency services please then contact Security, who will support the emergency services by escorting them to your location.

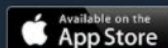
